




MultiCare Connected Care (MCC)

- » Wholly owned subsidiary of MultiCare Health System
- » Tacoma, WA based with footprint across WA state
- » Participating in MSSP Track 1+ since 2018, Enhanced Track with PY2022 start
 - 45 participating TINs with ~37,000 beneficiaries
- » Care Management program to outreach to high and rising risk patients
- » Utilize SNF 3-Day Waiver
- » Developed an SDOH closedloop referral program for MultiCare Health System





Current Efforts to Address SDOH

- » Different paths for different populations
 - Ambulatory Care Navigators (ACNs) for VBA patients (including ACO population)
 - Community Resource Hub for non-VBA patients
- » Community Resource Hub Pilot
 - Front office staff document social needs (food, housing, transportation, & financial insecurity are priority domains)
 - Patients with needs referred through EHR to Hub for further assessment
 - Hub uses closed-loop referral technology to refer patient to community services
- » Using Unite Us as closed-loop referral technology
 - Partner to onboard community organizations to the platform
 - Conduct regular check-ins with other funding health care organizations (hospitals, health plans, ACHs)
- » Advocating at the state level for this work to be adopted statewide
- » Seed funding partially provided by internal Foundation grants
 - Sustainability relies on the ability to prove ROI

Lessons Learned

- » Benefits of a neutral convener
- » Community Engagement is key
- » Go slow to go fast
- » We don't have a magic wand
- » Advocate, advocate, advocate
